






When I used to come to Rosies I always liked how the volunteers would remember that I only drank cold Milo, even when it was freezing out. The volunteer would see me coming and make me a cold Milo without even asking and it made me feel special that someone would remember a little detail like that.

I try and take the opportunity to do that for our regular patrons so that they know that someone cares about them and thinks they are special.
